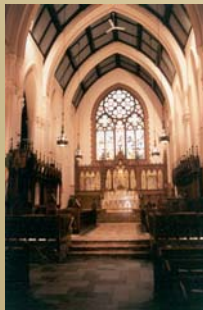

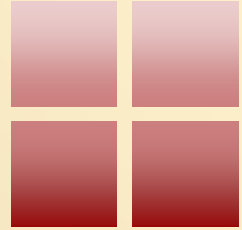

SAINT PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

This project involved restoration/renovation of the entire interior of this landmark building by the notable nineteenth century architect, Richard Upjohn. The building was consecrated in 1851 and gutted by fire in 1888. Upon rebuilding, after the fire, the interior was substantially modified and continued to be further altered over the subsequent decades.

We designed a new decorative painting scheme to return the interior to its early Victorian roots and enhance the expression of the building's gothic revival structure. The lighting was also designed to draw attention to the vertical height of the space, to highlight the structure and carved angel hammer beams, as well as to emphasize the liturgical focal points of the room.
